NOTE: Large amounts of construction material must be taken to the Vermilion Transfer Site. There is no charge for taxpayers within the County or the Town of Vermilion

- Household Waste
- Cardboard
- Used Oil and Filters
- Lead-Acid Batteries only
- Metal
- Freon Appliances (fridges & freezers)
- Propane Bottles
- Clean Agricultural Pesticide Jugs (not accepted at Kitscoty)
- Used Mattresses and Furniture
- Clean Burnables and Yard Waste
- Rolled Wire

ACCEPTED AT ALL SITES EXCEPT FOR TULLIBY LAKE AND PRESTON

- E-Waste (computers, monitors, printers, computer keyboards and televisions)
- Used paint in its original container
- Hazardous Waste in small quantities.

UPCOMING NEWS

Your Commission would like to advise you that we are currently working on our website. I hope to have this up and running by the spring of next year. Then you will be able to go on-line to get your transfer site and curbside pickup information.

Your Commission is in the planning stage for upgrades to our used oil and container collection. A new consolidation tank is in place at our Clandonald/Dewberry site, and we will be adding these to our other bigger sites in the next two or three years. We are hoping this will solve an ongoing problem we have experienced with spillage and should make our sites look much neater.

USED PAINT PROGRAM

You may drop off used paint in its original container at the Vermilion, Kitscoty, Marwayne, Dewberry and Paradise Valley sites. You will be directed where to dispose of this when you arrive at the site.

The product that is part of the current program includes the following:

- Used oil base paint
- Used latex paint
- Used stain
- Empty paint cans
- Aerosol paint cans

ANYTHING THAT IS NOT IN ITS ORIGINAL CONTAINER IS NOT PART OF THIS PROGRAM AND BELONGS IN HAZARDOUS WASTE

INFORMATION REGARDING CURBSIDE CARTS

I would like to remind people that your cart should be at your curb by 7:00 A.M. on the pickup day. Our contractor sets his route each week according to volumes.

Also I would like to remind people that household waste only goes in your residential cart. We will not accept other waste such as used lumber, tires, metal, etc. These items should be taken to your nearest transfer site..
