The Vermilion Recycling Centre is made possible through a recycling levy on the Town of Vermilion Utility Bills and through the sale of processed material. Reducing the amount of material being hauled to the Vermilion Regional Transfer Station and becoming more environmentally friendly are two major goals of the program.

can be dropped off at the bins located on the east side of the Lakeland Mall Parking Lot 
- ◆ **GREEN PRODUCTS (YARD WASTE)**
can be dropped off at green bins located throughout the Town from May to October or taken out to the Vermilion Transfer Station. **Yard waste does not include tree branches or trees.**

Thank you for using the Recycling Centre. By recycling, we are reducing the amount of material that is being transferred to the Beaver Regional Landfill which equates to reduced operating expenses.

You can help us by only bringing material that is recyclable and by sorting it as much as possible.

The following is a list of recyclable items and the manner in which they should be sorted:

PAPER PRODUCTS

All newspapers, magazines, and loose paper to be bundled or bagged and tied securely. Wet or soiled paper products can not be recycled.

Newsprint

- ◆ Newspapers & non-glossy flyers

Glossy paper

- ◆ Magazines, catalogues & flyers with a glossy finish

Telephone directories

- ◆ All telephone directories



Office paper

- ◆ All clean bond white & light colored paper

Mixed paper

- ◆ Recycled paper, brightly colored paper, construction paper, postcards & carbon forms

Books

- ◆ Paperback & hardcover books



Corrugated cardboard

- ◆ All corrugated cardboard, which includes most heavy type boxes, flattened.



Box board

- ◆ Lower category cardboard, including cereal boxes, with liners/packaging removed and flattened.
- ◆ Pre-rinsed cardboard milk cartons, flattened.

PLASTICS

Milk jugs

- ◆ All pre-rinsed plastic milk jugs, with lids off



Plastic film

- ◆ Grocery bags, packing plastics and most other household plastics are recyclable, bagged and tied.

Other household plastics

- ◆ Other pre-rinsed plastic containers, including ketchup, mustard, margarine containers with lids off.



"If you are unsure if a plastic container is recyclable, please bring it to the Recycling Centre for us to determine"

GLASS & TIN

Glass & Tin Cans

- ◆ Glass and tin cans are **only accepted at the Recycling Centre**. They must be free of food, have the labels removed and be separated from other recyclable items.

HAZARDOUS WASTE E-WASTE

Located at the Vermilion Transfer Station (north on Pare Drive)

- ◆ Old cellular telephones
- ◆ Ni-cad batteries



- ◆ Year round disposal of household paint, solvents and chemicals

Disposal for TV's, old computer components including hard drives, monitors, keyboards, printers and computer cables is available at the Vermilion Regional Transfer Station (no charge).
