BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF VERMILION TO AUTHORIZE  
THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VERMILION TO  
AMEND BYLAW NO. 14-2003 TO REGULATE HIGHWAYS AND  
PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF VERMILION

**TRAFFIC HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC PLACES BYLAW**

WHEREAS the Traffic Safety Act RSA 2000 cT-6 as amended or repealed and replaced from time to time, empowers the Council of the Town of Vermilion to pass Bylaws not in consistent with the Traffic Safety Act respecting Highways under its direction, control, and management for the regulation and control of vehicles, animals, and pedestrian traffic within the Town of Vermilion, and

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000 cM-26 as amended or repealed and replaced from time to time, authorizes the Council of the Town of Vermilion to pass Bylaws with respect to the safety, health, and welfare of people, the protection of people and property, activities or things done in or near public places and places open to the public, transport and transportation systems, and the enforcement of Bylaws within the Town of Vermilion, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Vermilion deems it to be in the best interest of the residents of the Town to regulate and control activities in relation to highways, public places, and parking on private property within the Town of Vermilion.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council for the Town of Vermilion, in the Province of Alberta duly assembled and pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the Traffic Safety Act and the Municipal Government Act, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 14-2003 is hereby amended by deleting Section 2.15 definition "Heavy Vehicle" and replacing it with the following:

2.15 – "**Heavy Vehicle**" means a vehicle with or without load exceeding any one of the following:

- 11 meters in length, or
- a maximum allowable weight of 7,200 kg., or
- tractor units which form by attaching as a power unit to semi-trailer(s)

Heavy Vehicles do not include recreational vehicles or transit vehicles.

2. Bylaw No. 14-2003 is hereby amended by deleting in its entirety Section 7.19.
3. Bylaw No. 14-2003 is hereby amended by changing the section reference in Schedule "A" as follows:

Offence	Section	Fine
Cling or attach to a Vehicle	6.02	\$ 30.00
Vehicle in Tow of Device	6.03	\$100.00
Bicycle over 50 cm on sidewalk	6.04	\$ 30.00
