Waste Collection Information (Roll out Bin Pick-up Only)

Placement of your bin

The bin requires approximately one metre on all sides so the automated truck can lift it. Place the wheels of the bin facing parallel with the curb and the metal bar parallel with the road, as illustrated in picture #1. Where there is no curb, place the bin on the edge of the traveled portion of the roadway. When there is a snow bank built up along the curb, make sure the bin is out further than the snow bank. We ask that you refrain from parking on the street on collection days, however, if there are vehicles on the street, please place the bin in the location illustrated in picture #2. When you are close to your neighbors bin please allow enough room between the two as illustrated in picture #3. Pictures #4, 5 & 6 show the incorrect ways of putting out your bin. Sidewalk placement is not an option.

Collection of your bin

To assure that your bin is picked up regularly please follow the pictures and have your bin out by 8:00 am on your collection day. All garbage must be bagged. It is best to not have your bin out for collection more than 24 hours prior to your collection day and remove all empty bins within 24 hours after collection. On occasion, we may not be able to provide service due to various reasons, such as improper placement of the bins or bins placed out after the truck has passed by. The Collection Operator will not collect any garbage not in the bin.

Storing, damaged, lost or stolen bins

Bins are the property of the Town of Vermilion and must remain with the property if you move. Each bin has a serial number on it that is corresponding with the property and helps to return a bin if it is lost and found. Bins may be stored anywhere on your property - in your garage, by your house or garage or in a shed. (preferably a shaded, cool spot.) If your bin requires repairs that is due to normal use over time please call the Engineering & Public Works Department. Bins may not be altered or painted. Bins that are damaged by improper use or abuse will be subject to a replacement cost of the bin being the responsibility of the home owner.
