We register bikes

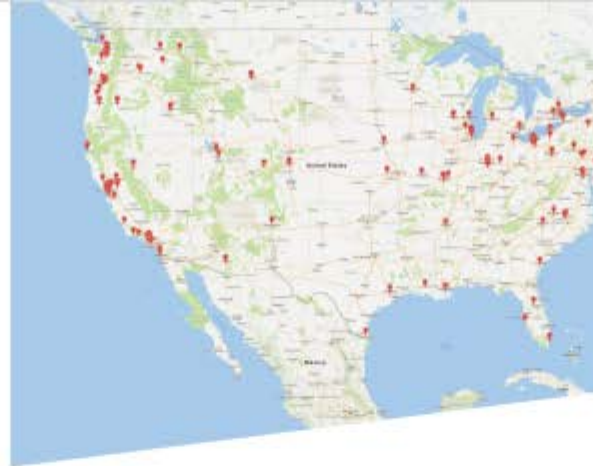
For absolutely free: online or in person at a local bike shop or donation drive. Right now, we're protecting over 225,000 bikes.

We're a data clearinghouse for stolen bikes

Our stolen bike listings have helped recover over 5,500 bikes to date, and is in use by dozens of police departments, numerous data-sharing partners, three universities, and hundreds of other organizations across the U.S. and abroad.

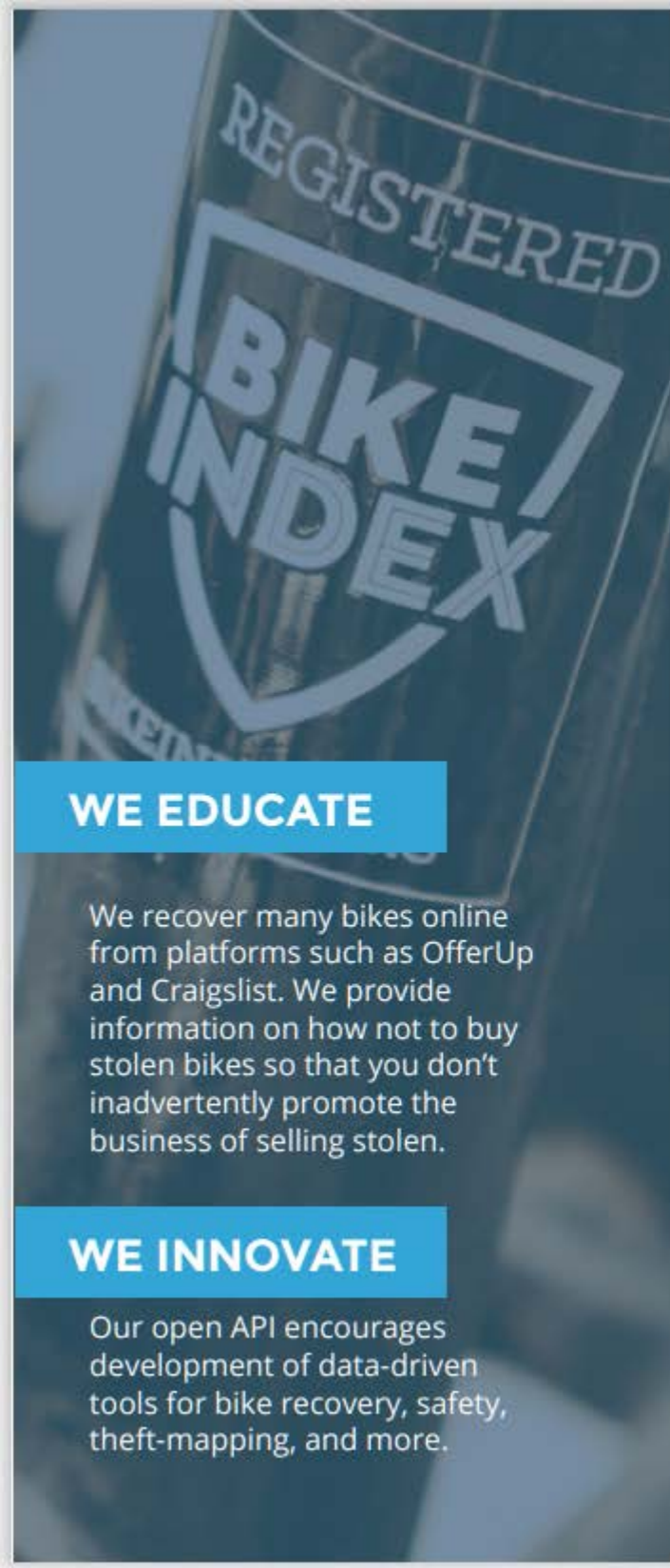


GET YOUR BIKE BACK
