2025 Tax Rate Bylaw

Council gave second and third reading to the Property Tax Bylaw No. 3-2025 with the following amendments:

2025 Vermilion Public Library Funding – Request for Decision

Council made a motion to approve the 2025 Library Budget Requisition in the amount of \$270,375.00 and to send a letter to the County of Vermilion River requesting an increase in their annual funding to adequately compensate for the 30% of County residents who utilize the facility and the services provided by the Vermilion Public Library

2025/2026 Policing Priorities – Request for Decision
