## BY-LAW 2-2017 OF THE

## **TOWN OF VERMILION**

(hereinafter referred to as the "Municipality")
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

## BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE TOWN OF VERMILION MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN (MDP) BY-LAW #18-2011

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Vermilion, upon recommendation from the Vermilion Intermunicipal Liaison Committee, deems it necessary to amend the Town of Vermilion Municipal Development Plan (MDP), being Bylaw #18-2011, and amendments thereto, to ensure conformity with the provisions of the Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP), being Bylaw #8-2016 and any amendments thereto.

The proposed revision to Section 11.3 of the MDP is to allow discretion to be used when considering the development or expansion of Confined Feeding Operations (CFO's) and manure storage facilities as an accessory to an Institutional use;

AND WHEREAS it is Council's intention to pass the By-Law and to hold a Public Meeting will be published in the Vermilion Standard on January 24 and 31, 2017.

AND WHEREAS a Public Meeting will be held on February 7, 2017 at 7:15 pm at the Town Hall and all persons and groups who wished to make a presentation to Council will be heard.

WHEREAS Section 638 of the Municipal Government Act requires that all statutory plans adopted pursuant to the Act be consistent with one another, the Council of the Town of Vermilion deems it appropriate to amend Section 11.3 of the Town of Vermilion Municipal Development Plan (MDP), being Bylaw #18-2011, and amendments thereto, to ensure conformity with the provisions of the Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP), being Bylaw #8-2016.

**NOW THEREFORE** Under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of Town of Vermilion, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Section 11.3 of Bylaw 18-2011, being the Town of Vermilion Municipal Development Plan, be amended as follows:

The Town does not support the creation or expansion of confined feeding operations (CFOs) within the Intermunicipal Development Plan boundary, however, consideration may be given to support the development of new and expanded CFOs and manure storage facilities if it is an accessory to an Institutional use such as a Public Education Facility.

Should any provision of this Bylaw be determined to be invalid, then such provisions shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.
