Business Arising from Prior Meetings

Alberta Municipalities (AB Munis) Resolution Update

Council for the Town of Vermilion received the AB Munis Resolution update as information. The 2026 resolution submission deadline for Alberta Municipalities is May 31, 2026. The County of Vermilion River has requested that the Town support the initiative by submitting the same resolution to Alberta Municipalities. The proposed resolution addresses brownfield redevelopment and contaminated properties, with the objective of strengthening advocacy efforts and advancing policy solutions in this area. The Town of Vermilion has approved the resolution and the official seconder is the Village of Marwayne.

Strategic Transportation Infrastructure Program (STIP) Letter of Support Update.

Council for the Town of Vermilion received the letter of support update regarding the Airport STIP application as information. The Town of Vermilion's Municipal Airport is an important regional asset that supports transportation, economic development, tourism, and emergency response services, including critical air medevac operations for rural residents. To support the Town's STIP application for airport improvements, Council directed administration to seek letters of support from neighbouring municipalities. To date, letters of support have been received from the Villages of Mannville and Kitscoty, while responses from Marwayne, Paradise Valley, Minburn County, Town of Elk Point and the City of Lloydminster are still pending. A follow up request will be submitted to the County of Vermilion River for their next Council meeting as directed by Council.

New Business

Request for Sponsorship from the Vermilion Agricultural Society for Canada Day 2026

Council for the Town of Vermilion received the request for sponsorship for the 2026 Canada Day Celebration hosted by the Vermilion Agricultural Society as information. The Vermilion Agricultural Society Canine Committee has requested support for the free 2026 Canada Day Celebration taking place on July 1, featuring family-friendly activities such as games, crafts, bouncy houses, stock dog trials, corgi races, fireworks, and community displays. The Town of Vermilion Parks, Recreation and Culture Board has

already approved \$600 in funding toward the event and the Town of Vermilion shall assist via in-kind contributions.

Financial

2026 First Quarter Financial Report

Council for the Town of Vermilion received the 2026 first quarter financial report as information. The quarterly financial report for the period ending March 31, 2026 was presented to Council as information. This report provided an overview of where each functional area of the budget is sitting, an update on each capital project, as well as reserve balances. Moving forward, Administration will continue to present financial reports to Council on a quarterly basis. The financial report will be posted on the Town's website to ensure easy access for the public, on the Budgets & Financial Reports page.

2025 Year End Surplus Allocation

Council for the Town of Vermilion approved the allocation of the \$798,391 2025 Year End Surplus into capital and operating reserves, as amended. At the April 22, 2026 Regular Council Meeting, Council was presented with the 2025 Audited Financial Statements, which were approved and are posted to the Town's website for public viewing. The audit confirmed a 2025 year-end surplus of \$798,391 for the Town of Vermilion. Administration proposed to utilize a portion of the 2025 surplus to fund 2025 carry forward projects, fund 2026 projects, and the remainder be put into reserves for future use.
