**Please note:** Children attending the program **MUST** be the age of 5 years of the starting date of the program (July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026)

Our program has always and will continue to offer a variety of packages that aim to accommodate each individual family. We offer daily (day) rates, weekly & the full 8-week program options available. 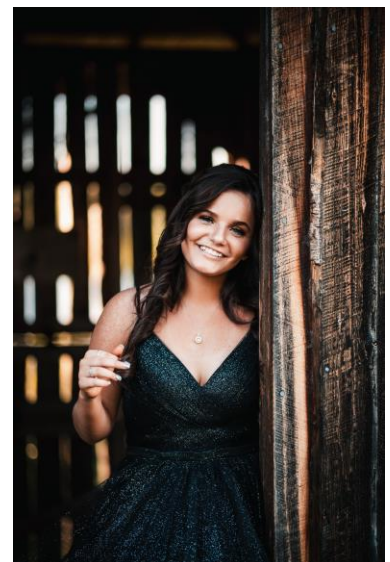

Hey, I'm Shelby!

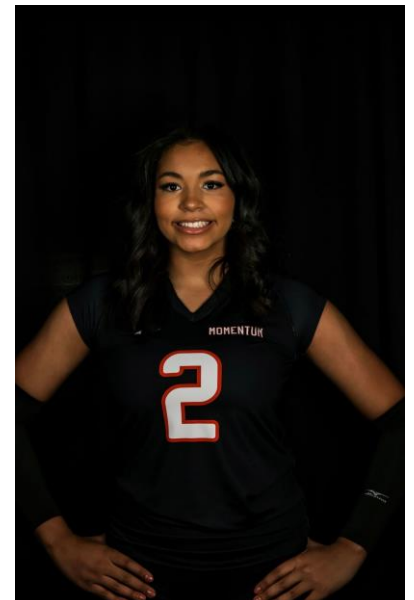

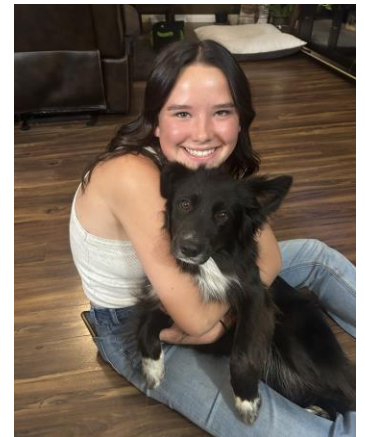
**Summer Fun Assistant: Halle Lehmann 18yrs**

## Required gear

This summer we will be spending loads of time outside, taking advantage of that sun and warm weather. We ask that your child(s) lather with that sunscreen prior to drop off. Staff will have sunscreen ready for when we are in direct sunlight. We also ask that the following items accompany your child(s):

- ☺ Insect repellent
- ☺ An extra set of clothes
- ☺ Labelled water bottle & labelled hat
- ☺ Sunscreen for afternoon application
- ☺ Bagged lunch with a midmorning snack & afternoon snack
- ☺ Bathing suit and bring a towel (Please send it every day! On hot days, we will most likely be visiting the spray park!
- ☺ Indoor closed-toe shoes
- ☺ Outdoor closed-toe shoes (comfy shoes, as we do lots of walking!)
- ☺ Any medication that may be required for the child

### Lunch box packing regulations

As some kiddos have **SEVERE** allergies to nuts, we ask that snacks and lunches have **NO NUT PRODUCTS**. This includes peanut butter and other chocolate snacks. If your child happens to bring a nut contained food item, staff will put it away in the kitchen until Pick up time and send a friendly reminder note about allergies. If the child has a “Wow butter” product, please just simply put a note in the lunch box, so we are aware!




### What not to bring

**We request parents not to send electronics and toys with their children to the Summer Fun program** except for the designated days where electronics will be permitted (please see our events calendar). It ensures that no electronic or toy is damaged or lost. Summer Fun provides toys, so there is no need to bring any! Any toy or personal items that may cause a problem throughout the summer will also be asked to stay at home.

(If you need to get in touch with your child, we have a Summer Fun phone they are more than welcome to have supervised access to! Or if they are a child who walks home/special circumstances they may bring an electronic, but it will either stay in the backpack or staff counter)

## Descriptions of each day

- **July 2<sup>nd</sup>:** First day of Summer Fun! Introduce themselves through Icebreaker crafts. Play and participate in activities until it's time to hit the pool! Bring a bathing suit, towel & anything else you'd need
- **July 3<sup>rd</sup>:** We have a local Greenhouse business coming in and teaching the kids about planting. They will each get to partake in planting their own and take it home! And participate in other plant themed activities/crafts and will head outside at some point for fresh air!
- **July 6<sup>th</sup>:** Science Day! This day will include many hands-on activities experimenting with safe science materials, making science-related crafts, and eventually heading out the doors for outside time!
- **July 7<sup>th</sup>:** Crazy Hair Day! The kids come to Summer Fun with unusual hair styles! Play games, make a craft related to the day and possibly head to the park
- **July 8<sup>th</sup>:** Future Career Dress Up Day! Kids/staff dress up as their future career goal! They will write letters to their future self, be involved in activities/crafts relating to the day and end the day with some sunshine!
- **July 9<sup>th</sup>:** Candyland! You dress up in colorful candy related colors, Golden ticket prizes. Candy related crafts, scavenger hunts, and Candy bingo! They will also be hitting up the Lakeland college pool for a fun swim!
- **July 10<sup>th</sup>:** Color/Artist Day! This is going to be a messy day! Lots of painting/crafting/color exploring! Day related games! Also wear some bright colors... But clothes that you can get messy with.
- **July 13<sup>th</sup>:** Role Model/Kindness Day! This is such a sweet day. Dress Up as your biggest Role Model... We will be writing letters to our role models, exploring what kindness means and practicing acting on it. Loads of activities and outside time as well
- **July 14<sup>th</sup>:** Animal Day! Such an exciting day planned. We have a family hauling in baby goats and baby calf's (all halter broken, very kind animals). The kids get to pet/interact with these animals all morning. They will then learn how to make Tallow and get to take some home. A multi-purpose tallow, safe for skin/hair etc. They'll learn animal importance, as well as have many activities related to the day.
- **July 15<sup>th</sup>:** Library Day! Due to changing bussing services, cost is a big difference. So, Library time isn't as frequent, but we still will provide readings to the kiddos throughout the summer. They will go to the library to read and buddy read. They will also have a craft to do there. Then head back to the regional Centre to play and be involved in day related crafts/activities. We will possibly walk to the Pizza Oven to be a part of the VIBE Day activity. **\*PICNIC LUNCH NEEDED\***
- **July 16<sup>th</sup>:** Under the sea! We will be crafting and playing activities that are related to the theme of the day. We will also be swimming at the local pool

- **July 17<sup>th</sup>:** Inside Out Day! Dress up as your favorite emotion/feeling! We will talk about and explore each feeling. Make crafts, activities, go outside and then finish off with one of the Inside Out Movies!
- **July 20<sup>th</sup>:** This will be an outside day! (**Unless the weather isn't cooperating**) **\*PICNIC LUNCH IS NEEDED\***. We will be at the park with mini golf, playing and the spray park. Sunscreen will be needed! Burning lots of energy type of day. Then we will come back, and have a calm ending towards the day
- **July 21<sup>st</sup>:** Christmas In July! One of our favorite days. Kids/staff are in PJs all day! The kids will be given a pancake breakfast while enjoying a day full of Christmas cheer! Loads of Christmas activities/crafts... They may watch a Christmas movie depending on the weather! If it's nice, we will go outside (Bring spare clothes, unless you're good with PJS outside). We are hoping to do a \$5 gift exchange for all the kids, so once we know who's signed up! We will email said parents to remind them about purchasing a \$5 gift.
- **July 22<sup>nd</sup>:** Lorax Day! Dress up in orange! We will be participating in Lorax related activities and crafts... Watching the lorax movie and going outside!
- **July 23<sup>rd</sup>:** Parade Day! The kids will be busy with activities until it's time to walk over for the parade! They will be able to bring a bag to collect candy. They will be recommended to wait till they get home before eating candy, so parents can check the candy. The remainder of the day will be filled with fun and sunshine!
- **July 24<sup>th</sup>:** Active Day! This day is specifically for the health of our body after Day 1 of the Vermilion Parade. Kids will be participating in workouts, challenges and races, outside time and coming home tired!
- **July 27<sup>th</sup>:** Firehall Day! This day is a fun but educational experience for kids to learn about fire safety. They will get to meet real firefighters and try out the water hose!
- **July 28<sup>th</sup>:** Amazing Race for kids! The kids will be grouped up, make team names, and participate in many challenges together. A good way to get the brains working but also having fun! They'll end the day with a movie to come home calmly!
- **July 29<sup>th</sup>:** Library Day! Reading, activities, and crafts. They will make a craft and then head back to the Regional Centre. Possibly participating in VIBE activities. Lots of outside time as well **\*PICNIC LUNCH IS NEEDED\***
- **July 30<sup>th</sup>:** Hawaiian Day! Dress up in your best Hawaiian/beach attire! We will be outside, making themed crafts, and going to the pool!
- **July 31<sup>st</sup>:** PJ & Mindfulness Day! This day is created to explore the importance of understanding Mental Health. They can come with PJ's on, bring a blanket. They will play, make crafts related to the day, go outside and learn how good the sun is for us. Participate in activities and go home feeling refreshed.
- **August 4<sup>th</sup>:** Happy Birthday Day! We will be celebrating with everyone! They'll decorate their own cake/cupcakes the way they want! A day filled with joy, lots of activities/crafts and outside time.

- **August 5<sup>th</sup>:** Monopoly Madness Day! All activities/crafts/play time are based on the game! They will receive monopoly money throughout the day for completing tasks... But then will have random bills to show up! At the end of the day, they empty their bank accounts and celebrate with their prizes! Fun way to learn about the value of a dollar.
- **August 6<sup>th</sup>:** Show & Tell Day! The kids bring something they'd like to show off to the rest of the kids. Go outside and go to the pool after lunch!
- **August 7<sup>th</sup>:** Spa & Electronics Day! A relaxing day... or a screen time day! Kids are allowed to bring their electronics to play at specific times! Others can receive hair do, get nails done & more.
- **August 10<sup>th</sup>:** Take Care of a Baby Day! Kids will be grouped up and required to take care of a baby! They will learn some important "First Aid/Stay Home Alone" tactics about caring for a baby. They learn what being responsible for another person looks like. While also implementing fun activities
- **August 11<sup>th</sup>:** Halloween Day! Kids are welcome to dress up in costume/Halloween colors. We will have games/activities/crafts and treats to go along with the day!
- **August 12<sup>th</sup>:** Lodge & Library Day! In the morning, we will visit the seniors at the lodge. Play games, interact, and have fun. Then we will head to the library for lunch and participate in reading activities. \*PICNIC LUNCH NEEDED\*
- **August 13<sup>th</sup>:** Beach Day! Dress up in summer beach wear! Play, go outside, do activities, make crafts, and go swimming!
- **August 14<sup>th</sup>:** Talent Show Day! Does your kid have talent? Show it off at our talent show! Then following with playing, crafts, activities!
- **August 17<sup>th</sup>:** Build Your Own Country Day! Starting from scratch, each kid will group up and design a flag, make their own laws, and conquer the day with their new country!
- **August 18<sup>th</sup>:** Carnival Day! This day is filled with games, crafting and fun. They get a handful of tickets and can play and enjoy the day with treats!
- **August 19<sup>th</sup>:** Game Show Day! A day full of fun and brain work! Complete Tasks, build up points and be faced with the prize or a mystery prize! Which team will go home with a winning title?
- **August 20<sup>th</sup>:** Mermaid/Merman Day! Create your dream tail! Play outside, have fun, and go swimming!
- **August 21<sup>st</sup>:** Last day of Summer Fun! Let's have the most fun and end with a dance party! Lots of last day sunshine and treats!

## Summer Fun policies and procedures

- The program will run Monday through Friday, starting July 2<sup>nd</sup> and ending August 21<sup>st</sup>
- **There will be no camp on Monday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> due to the Civic Holiday.**
- Program hours are 9:00am to 4:00pm, with supervision from 8:00am to 5:00pm.
  - Any child coming **before 8:00am will be subject to early drop off fee** and any child remaining **after 5:00pm will be subject to late pick up fee.**
  - During the lunch hour, most often between 12:00 to 1:00pm, the children are required to remain at the program
- Children must be signed in and out of the program daily
  - On the registration form, parents will indicate who has permission to pick up their child(ren). If children are to transport themselves, parents must sign a waiver when registering. If these are subject to change, parents **MUST** let one of the staff know, call or text Chloe in advance, letting us know that someone else is picking up your child(ren) from the program.
- Late measures
  - For safety measures, please call or text to inform Chloe if your child will be arriving late, or not attending for the day. If you do not receive a reply right away, please leave a message!
- Leaving mid-day
  - **If a child is to leave supervision during the day, the Program Coordinator must be notified in writing by a parent or guardian on the morning of that day.** Otherwise, no child is to leave the supervision of the Summer Fun staff during the hours of the program
- The Summer Program Assistants will be given equal responsibility for care of the children with the Program coordinator for their season
  
- Medications
  - If your child requires medication during camp time, the following procedures apply:
    - Put only the medication needed for that day into a sealed zip-lock bag and sign in the medication to the Program Coordinator
    - The sign in sheet will indicate the time that the medication must be taken, as well as any other necessary information

- ❑ The coordinator will give the child the medication bag at the designated time, and the child will administer their own medication

→ Bully and misbehavior

- We will be vigilant when addressing bullying and any other misbehaviors. The assistants will have the right to report incidents and behaviors to the Program Coordinator who will then take disciplinary action. Our priority is the safety and well-being of all the children in the program. If a child's behavior interferes with this goal, the child may be dismissed from Summer Fun **without a refund.**

**Please note:** As per policy, if a child requires an aide while at school, they are obligated to have your child accompanied by an aide for Summer Fun program as well. This can include but not limited to children with special needs, behavioral challenges and/or severe allergies\*\*

## Summer Fun Child Discipline Policy

Our staff is committed to delivering an enjoyable and safe program to all registrants. With this philosophy ever present in our minds, we follow an established discipline policy for dealing with behaviors that are not acceptable at Summer Fun. We recognize that all children need structure and guidance, and at times, may challenge Summer Fun rules; our leaders will be vigilant in asking all children to respect the rules which will be clearly posted and communicated. This discipline policy is meant to deal with more difficult behavior's by using a 3-step model as follows:

### Step 1:

- ✘ Child will be given a breather and opportunity to calm themselves; Summer Fun Coordinators will notify parents over the phone or speak with them at the end of the Summer Fun Day. A letter will be delivered to the parents as soon as possible to describe the behavior/incident, consequences applied, and confirmation that the child has moved to step 1 on or discipline policy

### Step 2:

- ✘ Child will be given a breather, with an opportunity to calm themselves; parents will be called immediately following the incident and will take the child home for the day. A letter will be delivered to the parents as soon as possible to describe the behavior/incident, consequences applied, and confirmation that the child has moved to Step 2 on our discipline policy

### Step 3:

- ✘ Child will be given a breather; the parent will be called immediately following the behavior and applied consequences will take the child home for the day. The child will not return to the Summer Fun Program for the remainder of 2026. Parents, Summer Fun Coordinator, and the Director of Community Services will meet in person as soon as possible to discuss the behaviors and consequences. There will be no refund even when a child is asked to leave the Summer Fun Program for any length of time.

**Please note:** Steps can be skipped (i.e., from Step 1 to Step 3) immediately depending on the severity of the child's behavior/incident and the judgement of the Summer Fun Coordinator and Director of Community Services.

At any time, parents can request a meeting with the Summer Fun Coordinator and/or the Director of Community Services to discuss concerns, children's behaviors, or ways to improve the overall Summer Fun experience.
